

The following is a brief description of our planned professional learning work for October 10th . This work is organized around our district's four collective goals:

- All students shall read, write, and communicate at grade level in both languages of instruction.
- All students shall be at grade level in numeracy.
- All students and staff will feel safe, cared for, and engaged in learning.
- All students shall graduate from high school.

Beaverbrook School staff will monitor the impact of their work from October 10th, and on subsequent professional learning days, in achieving these goals.

Literacy

 Grade 6-8 Teachers will participate in a collaborative book study Tackling Tough Texts facilitated by Central Office Literacy Team

Numeracy

- K-5 Teachers will engage in collaborative learning within Professional Learning Teams facilitated by Central Office Numeracy Team. The focus will be on high-yield instructional strategies that align with new math curriculum
- 6-8 Teachers will engage in ongoing professional learning using the *Plan-Do-Check-Act* cycle.

Safe, Cared For, and Engaged

 School Counsellors and Behavior Interventionists will collaborate on strategies and actions related to behavioral incidents, as well as self-regulation and de-escalation strategies for students

Graduation

 Specialty Teachers (Art, Music, PE) will collaborate on the use of Artificial Intelligence within specialty subject areas; session facilitated by Central Office Staff.
