Professional Learning Day 17th APR

The following is a brief description of our planned professional learning work for April 17th, 2026. This work is organized around *Anglophone East School District's* four collective goals:

- All students shall read, write, and communicate at grade-level in both languages of instruction
- All students shall be at grade-level in numeracy
- All students and staff will feel safe, cared for, and engaged in learning
- All students shall graduate from high school

K-5 Literacy Teachers will engage in learning how to best use the literacy resources available for effective lesson planning in support of all learners.

6-8 Literacy Teachers will continue to engage in collaborative book study *Tacking tough Texts* facilitated by Central Office curriculum team.

6-8 Numeracy Teachers will explore the use of math manipulatives and math games to support differentiation of instruction and formative assessment.

K-8 Music Teachers will explore Escape Rooms to reinforce musical concepts, collaboration and spark excitement for learning.

K-8 Art Teachers: will continue with their exploration of murals.

K-8 PhysEd Teachers will learn about Jump Rope (Part 1) and Assessment Practices (Part 2)

Educational Assistants will engage in the study of the Function Behavioral Assessment

EST-School Counsellors: will continue training in EFT (Tapping: *Emotional Freedom Technique*) a therapy type that combines features of psychotherapy with acupuncture (continued from last session)

Behavior Intervention Mentor: trauma-informed ABA webinar (Part 1 of 2)
